Special Reports:

SVMX- MX series finale at Sandy Valley Motocross. Was cancelled it did not look good for MRAN. Kit is not present to speak so Lance Gilman spoke on his behalf. Nothing to report.

Wild Bunch: May 16th Delmar area, 110 Big Bikes and 50 mini's. Good turn out. Everything went smooth. The tree section was awesome. There were only 2 injuries. There were 2 issues with parents getting upset about their riders being on the course too long. One of them is here to discuss. Dustin White presented his argument and Richard Hersh represented the Wild Bunch. After much discussion the club has decided to give him a warning and the next time he gets confrontational and argumentative in that manner he will be suspended. Abusive unsportsmanlike behavior will not be tolerated. Tina Flowers was not present to discuss she did provide a letter to be

read. The main concern is that alcohol was a factor in her behavior. After much discussion it has been decided that Tina will be on probation for a year and if she has the same behavior again she will be banned.

The language in the rule book will be addressed at the next meeting to cover the no drinking policy at the event.

Wild Bunch Nigh race: June 6th Jean area. Race went well very organized.

Coyote Desert: June 20th Ely: 48 mile loop big bike exp and ama do 2 loops to finish. Mini Exp do one loop. Start by class 30 second intervals. Finish time not decided yet. No camping in the pit area. Camping is close by.

Ground Shakers Desert: July 4th & 5th Caliente area flyer out. Big bikes on Sat with 65's and 50's. The 85 and open mini will race on sun. Tech insp at sign ups for spark arrestors. Pits, camping and sign ups at the rodeo grounds. Start by the grocery store by branding iron. They go up the hill after the start. A lot of events happening in town on Sat for the 4th. Make sure all riders have water it is going to be hot and dusty.

Unfinished business:

2010 Classes/Division: Bret Marshall has some suggestions. Passed out a breakdown of classes and did some research. Open move to Heavy Weight (380cc and up) add a middle weight (240cc-378cc) and a light

weight (100- 230cc). No change to the womens class and eliminate the 4stk over/under. Some minor changes to the vet class.

Carl Courier: recommends getting rid of the odd number age groups and only have even numbers in the vet classes.

Bob Maichle: Wants to keep age groups in the vet class and just change the classes based on cc's.

Wendy McMeans: Wants to add a powder puff class to the womens division. Something for the girls that want to race.

Zack will post a proposal on the website for input. We need to add something for the 16-19 year olds to give them a transition from mini to big bike.
