

The November 2th, 2009 MRAN meeting was called to order at 7:10pm.

Approve Minutes: Bob Maichle motioned to approve and was seconded by Jason Ellis.

President's report: He got a call last week from a guy selling gas mats. They are \$125 each. He's been working with the BLM and actually called the supervisor, but he did not know what he was talking about. Needs to work on squashing it and we are doing a good job with it. He doesn't see why we need to buy certain mats. He has sent comments in on Chief Mountain. If we get our dates down he will get that report to the Lincoln County special events committee to get our dates down so that we can get that done for 2010. Coming up in the Vegas district they are going to start having some meetings to redo their R&P and to add designated pit areas to utilize more trails for racing. We are still trying to get the separation between bikes and truck/buggy. Maybe we should get a committee together so that when he can't make a meeting somebody can. Also Nellis dunes committee meeting is on the same night as the MRAN meeting so he can't go. So far Dino is the only one attending. Would somebody else like to do that so that we are

represented? Nicole from BCMX said she would consider it. It is at the county building the first Monday of the month at 6:00pm.

Vice President Report: Not much new happening.

Treasurer Report: Not present, read by Zack Livreri. Insurance, Banquet and trophies need to be paid. He also working on getting a sponsorship from Rocky Mountain. The motion to approve the report was made by Sean McDaniel and seconded by Troy Hunter.

Referee Report:

Big Bike ref Scott Glimp: EVRR race there were 20 day cards and 2 2nd division. Darkside had 7 day cards and 3 2nd division and 1 mini.

Mini Ref Brian Shierberl: Not present.

GP Ref Sean McDaniel: Everything is good.

Web Report by Scott Glimp: Everything is good, working on getting online payment feature. There have been problems for people trying to use the IP address instead of the web address. Users have to use the .com address for access.

Public Lands Officer Mike Payne: Not present he had been spending a lot of time at the BLM office.

PR report by Kevin Davies: There are 2 things he is working on. First, MRAN should be sanctioned by the AMA. They are not looking to take over just to be a sanctioning body. They don't have any problems with our rules. The only thing they request is that the Refs fill out an AMA race report after every race. It would benefit us with more variety and insurance savings. It will cut back on MRAN card costs since the

insurance will be cheaper. But it will cost members money to join AMA. All members will have to join. It may bring in more members. Will the Sugar Loafer have a problem with us being a racing association? They put on a lot of races in Utah and might not like us joining. MRAN would probably be district 26. Nevada is the only state that is split in 3 districts. Still need to work out some details maybe for 2011.

The other topic is that he thinks the Claim Jumper ban should be lifted in 2010. Committee response is that if they wanted it lifted they would come to a meeting and ask for it. There seems to be some negativity regarding the subject. It is up to the club to present what they want.

Special Reports:

EVRR desert race October 10th Utah. 122 big bikes, 15 day cards, 7 minis. Only 2 minor injuries, nobody used the ambulance. The race went well there were 4 DNF's in the big bike race. Trophies will be ready in a couple of weeks. Jason St John is here to discuss the mini race. He thinks the riders that did not do the lap minimum should be DNF'd. The club disagrees and finished all riders. They were unaware of the minimum lap rule and told the riders that they would have a finish. The competition committee will overrule the club decision. The motion was made by Jay Livingston and 2nd by Jason Ellis vote to follow rule book 12, 3 oppose. The mini rider will be DNF'd.

Dark side Desert race, October 31st & Nov 1st Mercury area, the race went well. 83 big bikes and 2 mini's. There were 2 injuries. There was a problem with course cutting. The club is working on it.

SVMX November 14th Sandy Valley, Hoping for a good turnout. The course will go out by the farm again. It will be a one day event flyer up.
