Web Report by Scott Glimp: The new site should be up and running soon, just putting the finishing touches on, and trying to put up the results and standings and having trouble converting them. The pit board forums will have to be recreated. They will not be able to transfer.

Public Lands Officer Mike Payne: It's been a busy couple of weeks. Fees for the Bio's for the Darkside, Gamblers, and Jack rabbits will be covered by the BLM fees and do it internally. We have been trying to keep MRAN separate from the trucks and buggies. We don't tear up as much course as they do. He went out with Mark Sanchez to look for new areas around Pahrump.

PR report by Kevin Davies: Wants to get a hold of Tarkanian or Lowden to see if we can support one of the candidates for Harry Reid's seat. Checking with AMA and getting info for putting races together. The classes are not a big deal but the issues of protest are different. They want to handle all protest not the competition committee. He will go back to clubs for input. It may also help to get sponsorships since they are heavily sponsored. Bob is not happy with them for the way that they split up Nevada in the districts. Special Reports:

Wild Bunch night race August 8th Jean. The race went well. No complaints.

Bushwaker desert race September 19th Panaca. The start and pits will be at the rodeo grounds. Alternate gas 22 miles, 2 loops Exp, Ama, 1 loop novices. Same area as last year with some changes. Mini's 10 mile loops run for 1.5 hours. Women will do 1 lap.

Ground Shakers GP October 3rd Beatty. Flyer will be out this week. 1 day event 4-5 mile course. New start and new sections added.

EVRR desert race October 10th Utah. Virgin course 30% done will be finishing up this weekend and will have more info. 1st half will be on top plains then drop down into the gorge with trees and water. 15-18 miles loop 45-50 minutes for a lap. There will be a gate fee for non-MRAN members. There will also be some vendors there.

Banquet is in January 16th 2010.

2010 Classes/Division:

Light weight- any full frame bike up to 240cc designated with a letter A. There will be no 500cc or 65 cc bikes allowed. A senior mini AMA or Exp may race this class with Ref discretion. Three classes NOV, AMA, EXP

Middle weight- Any full frame bike up to 375cc designated with the letter X. Three classes NOV, AMA, EXP.

Heavy weight- Open-any full frame bike. No letter designation. Three classes NOV, AMA, EXP.

Vet, women and Mini classes stay the same.

Powder Puff- Still working on the details.

Late Trophies: Mesquite said he has the trophies and will get them to Sean. LOD does not have the trophies MRAN will order and sanction the club. Vote to approve unanimous 0 oppose.
