New Buisness

A motion was passed to allow Jeff Landers to conduct business with Bank of America on behalf of the Motorcycle Racing Association of Nevada which also does business as MRAN. MRAN is a registered DBA name in Clark County, NV.

Jeff McMeans reported that Zack talked to the mini ref's and Bryan & mike will be stepping down and Kim Livreri will be taking over for the remaing of the year.

We need to create a process for the Grand Prix's and Desert races to follow so all things are on the same page.

Sean McDanielshad this to say :

After some discussion with other Officers and Members I have to put together some suggestions that I hope will promote consistency throughout the GP series among all the clubs. There are (2) options I have and they are as follows.

OPTION #1

1. CLUBS TO END SIGN UPS 1 HOUR PRIOR TO RACE STARTING TO ENSURE THAT ITS MEMBERS HAVE ENOUGH TIME TO ENTER THE RIDERS INTO A DATABASE.
2. CLUBS TO HAVE A MEMBER(S) CHECKING THE STAGING AREA PRIOR TO THE BEGINNING OF EACH RACE TO MAKE SURE THE RIDERS HAVE THE PROPER NUMBERS AND BACKGROUNDS DISPLAYED. ALSO TO MAKE SURE THAT THE RIDER IS IN FACT SIGNED UP FOR THAT RACE.
3. CLUBS TO HAVE RESULTS POSTED WITHIN 1 HOUR OF THE RACE COMPLETION. UPON POSTING OF THE RESULTS, RIDERS WILL HAVE 1 HOUR TO PROTEST RESULTS. RESULTS WILL BE FINAL AFTER THAT ONE HOUR. PROTESTS WILL BE HANDLED WITH THE PROTESTEE, REFEREE AND CLUB.
4. TROPHIES WILL BE GIVEN OUT ON RACE DAY. NAMES WILL NOT BE ON TROPHIES HOWEVER PLACE AND CLASSIFICATION WILL BE.
5. NEW CLUBS WILL NEED TO BE INTERVIEWED AND APPROVED BY THE COMPETITION COMMITTEE PRIOR TO THEM SANCTIONING A GP. A MONETARY RETAINER MAY BE SUGGESTED TO ENSURE THE GUIDELINES ARE FOLLOWED BY NEW CLUBS.

OPTION #2

1. CLUBS TO END SIGN UPS 1 HOUR PRIOR TO RACE STARTING TO ENSURE THAT ITS MEMBERS HAVE ENOUGH TIME TO ENTER THE RIDERS INTO A DATABASE.
2. CLUBS TO HAVE A MEMBER(S) CHECKING THE STAGING AREA PRIOR TO THE BEGINNING OF EACH RACE TO MAKE SURE THE RIDERS HAVE THE PROPER NUMBERS AND BACKGROUNDS DISPLAYED. ALSO TO MAKE SURE THAT THE RIDER IS IN FACT SIGNED UP FOR THAT RACE.
3. KEEP CURRENT RESULTS RULES IN EFFECT.
4. KEEP CURRENT TROPHY RULES IN EFFECT.
5. NEW CLUBS WILL NEED TO BE INTERVIEWED AND APPROVED BY THE COMPETITION COMMITTEE PRIOR TO THEM SANCTIONING A GP. A MONETARY RETAINER MAY BE SUGGESTED TO ENSURE THE GUIDELINES ARE FOLLOWED BY NEW CLUBS.

If there are any other ideas that some of you may have please feel free to get ahold of Sean McDaniels. He is always open to others suggestions.

This will be discussed at the September MRAN meeting which will be on September 13th at 7:00 PM. Please plan on attending if you would like to discuss this along with the competition committee.

Gina Wilson from the Wild Bunch wrote up a proposal for a rule book change.

Proposed New Rule:

Participant pins and/or finisher pins are required for all MRAN Desert series events. Sponsoring clubs must have pins at their race. If the hosting club does not have pins at their event they will be fined \$200.00. If pins are not provided sponsoring club will be fined \$500.00

Purpose of new rule :

To make the Desert Series Consistant so pins are mandantory at all Desert Series Events.

Affected Sections of the Rule Book:

Desert series sponsoring a race. Article 5 Section 17H
