January 16th MRAN Banquet – \$25 dollars for adults - \$10 for kids under 12. Everything is going good, everything is ordered hope to see everyone there. Zack asked clubs not to reserve tables unless they can fill them to avoid extra costs.

January 23rd Gamblers Desert Race – All races will be held on Saturday – Signup the day of the race will start at 6:00am – 65cc, 85cc, Open Mini and Junior Women will race at 7:30am, 9.5 mile loop, 3 laps for leader - 50cc will start at 9:30 race for 1 hour – Big bikes start at 11:30am 40 mile loop, 2 laps. 2 bikes every 30 seconds.

Unfinished Business

2010 Calendar – 2 GP’s were added April 24th at Pine Valley Utah and June 12th at Cedar City Utah – Brent Kirk paid \$100 dues and started a new club named SUN Riders and they will host these events. MRAN posters are going to be made to help promote MRAN series – Sean McDaniel made motion to spend \$1000 dollars on promotional items – Jay Livingston 2nd the motion – No one was opposed motion carried. Jeff McMeans and Bryan Schierberl will work with different companies and get the project finished.

Discussion on Quads seven GP races will allow quads – Sandy Valley (2), Boulder City (2), Groundshakers (1), Sun Riders (2) , Coyotes (?).

New Business

- a. One lap finishes – Jay Livingston – Discussion on finishing of Desert Races. Motion was made by Jay Livingston to Change Article 5, Section 9, part C to read as follows: *“For Multiple Lap Races: “The sponsoring member club shall designate a separate finishing chute for minimum lap finishers while the race is in progress. The minimum lap finisher chute shall be located a minimum of 10 feet from the race course and within a maximum of 20 yards from the designated scoring area. Minimum lap finishers will be scored once they enter minimum lap finish chute and will not be allowed to continue with the race. If a rider passes the minimum lap chute and enters the pit area rider will be scored as a DNF if he does not complete the next lap. All bikes shall remain in the minimum lap chute until checkered flag is waived.” Also included in the Motion was to take the sentence out of part D that allowed clubs to require more than the MRAN minimum and to change the minimum lap requirements to reflect the GP table. “Bryan Schierberl 2nd the motion – 13 voted for motion, 1 vote against, 7 not voting, motion carried.*

Overall point’s champion – logistics – Will score like AMA Hare n Hound Scoring; Only riders in MRAN clubs will be eligible for points; will discuss next meeting about awards for this Championship; minimum top three overall points winners will get trophies at end of year; Only for Desert series.

Discuss finishes, starts, bike #'s and course markings with all clubs – all clubs given a rule book and ask to read it.

MRAN Traylor – Needs to be kept clean and everything put back after clubs use it.
